In the Dallas Holocaust and Human Rights Museum's inaugural special exhibition—*Stories of Survival: Object. Image. Memory.*—find out what Survivors of global conflicts brought with them on their harrowing journeys to freedom. This highly-intimate exhibition showcases the work of award-winning photographer Jim Lommasson and his photographic prints of over 60 salvaged items—a family photo album, a prayer book, and a teddy bear, among others—brought to America from Armenia, Bosnia, Cambodia, Iraq, Rwanda, South Sudan, Syria, and the Holocaust.

Stories of Survival: Object. Image. Memory. has been published in conjunction with an exhibition organized by the Illinois Holocaust Museum & Education Center and is a joint project of the Illinois Holocaust Museum and photographer Jim Lommasson.



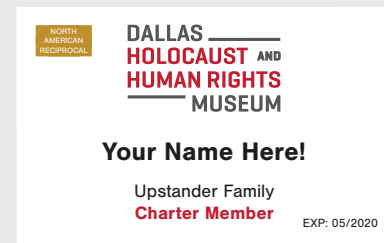
The new Dallas Holocaust and Human Rights Museum has opened the doors to our new home, and a 40-year dream has become a reality.
