What is the Museum Experience Fund?

Through the generosity of our donors, we are pleased to offer grants from our Museum Experience Fund. These grants cover admission for your students and accompanying teachers/chaperones. Funds are available on a first-come, first-served basis to the following groups:

Title 1 Schools: Schools qualified as Title 1 can apply for free admission.

Catholic Schools: Catholic schools in the Diocese of Dallas can apply for free admission and a partial transportation reimbursement.

Economically Disadvantaged Groups: Non-Title 1 designated schools and individual groups can provide information about need for assistance and apply for free admission.

East Texas Initiative: Public schools, private schools, and home school groups located in TEA Regions 7 and 8 (East Texas) can apply for free admission and a partial transportation reimbursement.

What is included in the grant?

All school groups receive a TEKS-aligned tour of our permanent exhibit. Groups may also tour the special exhibition and view a presentation in our Cinemark Theatre. In addition, groups may request to participate in our Dimensions in TestimonySM interactive experience.

How do I apply for the grant?
